2) Adding aspects to Class Charts

Class Charts will pull through all Capita's standard SIMS data as default but if you wish to include custom aspects which your school has created then they need to be member of a sub category called Edukey (with Xporter as the main category).

Main Category = Xporter

Sub Category = EduKey

Troubleshooting adding aspects from SIMS

The 'Add from SIMS' button is not showing

This indicates the data was not received. The most common possibilities here are:

- The Xporter category and Edukey sub-category were not ticked in SIMS for that aspect
- The data in that aspect is older than 1 year
- There is no existing data for pupils in that aspect

The aspects have been received and applied to the seating charts, but grades are missing for some pupils

The issue here is likely to be related to the age of the data. By default, Xporter will only export data which is up to 1 year old. If you need to export data older than 1 year, please get in touch through support@classcharts.com and request that we expand the data collection timeframe for your school.





3) Setting up Behaviours in Class Charts

If your school has come on board with the behaviour management option in Class Charts then you will need to setup the behaviours available for staff.

The first step is to decide which behaviours are most commonly used by staff, then it is just a matter of clicking on an image and playing matchup.

- Check all emails are school emails (we can update in bulk for you if required).
- Delete emails for any staff who you do not want to have access to system / add any missing emails for staff who should.
- Decide who should be "Analytics" users most likely SLT & pastoral (maybe also subject heads up to you).
- Any staff you wish to have access at an early stage click "Set password"
- Once ready for roll out click "Send Account details" Teachers who have not yet accessed their accounts will then get an email with their log-in information.





5) School settings in depth

Modules:

Enabled-Allows teachers to make a record of correct/incorrect answers during a Q+A session (recommended)

Disabled - No Q+A capability

Enabled-Teachers can use Class Charts room creating software (RECOMMENDED)

Disabled-Pupils appear in list view in classes

Enabled- This allows staff to download access codes for pupils to view their behaviour report (RECOMMENDED)

Disabled-Staff can't download access codes for pupils to view their behaviour report

Enabled- Allows staff to add notes to pupil profiles either for the admins to view or all other staff (RECOMMENDED)

Disabled-Staff can't add notes to pupil profiles

Enabled- Allows staff to view the pupil list (RECOMMENDED)

Disabled - Hides the pupil list

Enabled-All staff can award out of classroom behaviours (RECOMMENDED)

Admin and Analytics users only-Only people with these permissions can award out of classroom behaviours

Disabled - no attendance information is pulled through or displayed (RECOMMENDED)

Enabled - designed for primary schools, can take attendance in Class Charts but is not written back to any MIS

Display Only - Class Charts will pull attendance information through from SIMS and display it in class and pupil reports, not designed for taking attendance

Enabled-Allows teachers to award behaviour points (RECOMMENDED)

Disabled-Doesn't allow behaviour points to be awarded

Enabled- This allows staff to download access codes for parents to view their child's behaviour report (RECOMMENDED)

Disabled-Staff can't download access codes for parents to view their child's behaviour report

Enabled- This allows staff to create rewards in the reward store and allows pupils to purchase rewards with spendable behaviour points (RECOMMENDED)

Disabled- Disables the reward store

Enabled-All staff can view the activity feed of behaviour (RECOMMENDED)

Admin and Analytics users only-Only people with these permissions can view the activity feed of behaviour

Disabled- No one can see the activity feed



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Enabled - cover teachers allows users of Class Charts to start a session in a class that they are not assigned to (RECOMMENDED)

Enabled - this allows teachers to view other teacher's statistics such as behaviours awarded (RECOMMENDED)

Enabled - teachers can create and edit rooms. (Recommend if not SIMS)

Disabled - teachers can't move desks around rooms.

Edit only - teachers can edit the room layout. (Recommended for SIMS schools)

Enabled- teachers can add new text-based custom fields, new yes/no custom fields or a new target field.

Disabled-Only admins can do the above (RECOMMENDED)

Enabled - teachers can edit dates of behaviour incidents (RECOMMENDED)

Disabled - teachers cannot edit dates of behaviour incidents

Enabled - teachers can edit behaviour incidents created by other teachers (RECOMMENDED)

Disabled - teachers cannot edit behaviour incidents created by other teachers

Enabled - teachers can create custom behaviours

Disabled - teachers cannot create custom behaviours (RECOMMENDED)

Enabled - teachers can create classes

Disabled - teachers cannot create classes (RECOMMENDED)



Pupils and Parents:

Negatives Only -Comments attached to negative behaviours only will show in activity feed.



Enabled -Parents and pupils can see their behaviour score breakdown, weekly behaviour breakdown and activity feed.

Disabled - Parents and pupils can see their behaviour score breakdown and weekly behaviour breakdown.

Parents only -Parents can see their behaviour score breakdown, weekly behaviour breakdown and activity feed. Pupils can only see their behaviour score breakdown and their weekly behaviour breakdown.

Pupils only - Pupils can see their behaviour score breakdown, weekly behaviour breakdown and activity feed. Parents can only see their behaviour score breakdown and their weekly behaviour breakdown.

Enabled - Teacher and lesson name will appear for each behaviour in the activity feed.

Disabled - Teacher and lesson name will not appear for each behaviour in the activity feed.

Positives Only - Teacher and lesson name will appear for positive behaviours only in the activity feed.

Negatives Only - Teacher and lesson name will appear for negative behaviours only in the activity feed.

For these settings we cannot recommend default settings as we do not know how much access your school wishes to give to parents in regards to viewing behavioural information





Behaviours:

Enabled - You can attach an outcome to a behaviour incident.

Enabled (synchronise with SIMS) - You can attach an outcome to a behaviour incident with a list of outcomes synchronised with the outcomes you have set in SIMS (RECOMMENDED)

Disabled - Cannot attach an outcome to a behaviour incident

Enabled - teachers can leave comments on behaviour incidents (RECOMMENDED)

Disabled - teachers cannot leave comments on behaviour incidents

This option counts behaviour points toward the displayed bubbles and in the pupils list Teachers- teachers and school admins can customise behaviours

School admin - doesn't allow teachers to choose or customise behaviours (RECOMMENDED)

This option counts behaviour points toward each pupil's spendable points for reward store

These three boxes allow behaviours recorded in SIMS to show in Class Charts. You have to enter a date in the boxes and then Class Charts will begin to display data from SIMS from that point onward. Class Charts can't pull through points awarded in SIMS previous the current date. (RECOMMENDED) Enabled - teachers can award negative behaviours and deducts spendable points

Enabled, except rewards store teachers can award negative behaviours, does not deduct spendable points. (RECOMMENDED)

Disabled - teachers can't award negative behaviours.

Enabled - teachers can refer behaviour incidents to other members of staff (RECOMMENDED)

Disabled - teachers cannot refer behaviour incidents to other members of

This option counts behaviour points toward triggering intelligence events



Custom fields:

Yes - staff can choose all of their own custom fields without any being default

Yes (force default fields) - staff can choose some of their own custom fields but must also display default fields (RECOMMENDED

Modern - Class Charts modern card design allows up to 8 custom fields on each side of the card and can display (RECOMMENDED)

Classic - Pupil cards display one behaviour score and 4 custom fields and are not flippable

Points from current class only - this display points from the current class only in the points bubbles

Teacher set- teacher chooses the option in account settings

Points from all classes - this displays points from all classes in this points bubbles

Enabled - displays cartoon faces in place of photos

Disabled - uses pupil photos or silhouettes if there are no photos.

6) Using intelligence events in Class Charts

1) What are they?

Intelligence events are rules that you can setup in Class Charts Analytics that will perform actions when certain conditions are met.

Some examples:

You have a rule in school that if there are 3 or more negative issues in a day then a student automatically gets a detention. You can setup intel events to inform the relevant member of staff the students this has occurred for.

You have specific students on behaviour report and you want your school's Behaviour Support Officer and an Assistant Head to be informed if 3 negative incidents occur in a day for one of these students.

You want each Head of Year to be made instantly aware if a student in their year group receives 10 positive points in 1 week.

These are just a few example rules – you can setup your own to suit your school's needs and practices.

2) Who can setup intelligence events?

Anyone with "Analytics" permissions can setup intel events.

3) Who can receive intelligence notifications?

Any member of staff can be designated to be informed when specific things happen. They will receive an email and also get a notification when they log in to Class Charts – the number of new notifications is shown on the bell to the top right of the screen.







4) How do you set them up?

Give the event a name and then you will be able to set some options:

Set a start date and end date (eg this academic year) and put a tick in the Active box.

Then set up you rule, you can choose:

- Number of points or number of intelligence event incidents.
- The time frame (eg in 1 day or 1 week).
- A single or multiple conditions (eg, specific students, classes, teachers, year groups or types of behaviour)

You can then set the action:

- Highlight the event in the activity feed.
- Inform specific members of staff.
- Award additional "bonus" points.
- or a combination of these.

In this example if a pupil in Year 9 gets 3 negative points for refusing in 1 week then the intel event will be highlighted in the activity feed and Mrs Dawn Asher (Head of Year 9) will get an email and a notification next time she logs into Class Charts.
